2016 ADELAIDE HILLS 'SASHIKO' CHARDONNAY

The 2016 vintage composed of low winter rainfall and a dry spring, irrigation commenced before flowering. One significant rainfall in late January was perfectly timed, resulting in high quality grapes. These grapes were harvested on the third of March in the cool of the early morning and delivered to the winery at 6:00am where they were immediately pressed.

Free run juice and pressings were fermented separately, 30% of juice saw French oak. After partial malolactic fermentation, the wine was left on yeast lees until racking just prior to bottling in October.

TASTING NOTES -

This straw-coloured Chardonnay has fresh and lively aromas of citrus, white peach and freshly cut melon. It tastes of stone fruits with further hints of melon. Lightly oaked, it has nuances of stone fruit and slithered almonds that combine with a long crisp finish.

FOOD MATCH -

This wine matches extremely well with fresh tastes of summer; white peach, prosciutto, and rocket salad; zucchini fritters with prawns and celeriac mayonnaise; goat cheese and fresh herb salad.
